APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Admissions Policy

Beal College has a rolling admissions policy which means that a candidate will be considered for acceptance as soon as his or her application for admission and application fee are received.

How to Apply

1. Applicants must submit the following to the Beal College Admissions Office:

- a. A **completed application**.
- b. A **non-refundable \$25.00 APPLICATION FEE**. Make check or money order payable to: BEAL COLLEGE. **Applications received without the application fee will not be processed.**
- c. **Official high school transcript**. You must make arrangements for the transcript to be sent directly to the Beal College Admissions Office from the high school. **Transcripts carried or sent by students will not be considered official.** Contact your high school guidance office.
- d. **GED test results** (for non-high school graduates only). You must make arrangements for the test scores to be sent directly to the Beal College Admissions Office from the Department of Education in the state issuing the GED. Call (207) 624-6752 to reach the State of Maine Department of Education.

Those students who have earned their high school diploma through home school education must provide passing GED scores. Students who cannot produce adequate documentation of graduation from high school will be asked to sit for a GED. For those students who have earned at least an Associate Degree and whose final official college transcript indicates a high school graduation date, an official college transcript may be submitted in lieu of the above forms.

- e. **Transfer students**. Please submit all official college transcripts from other institutions if you plan to apply as a transfer student. You must make arrangements for the transcript(s) to be sent directly to Beal College, Attention Registrar, from the college or university. **Transcripts carried or sent by students will not be considered official.**
 - f. **Immunizations**. All degree-or-diploma-seeking students born after December 31, 1956 must provide proof of two doses of immunization against measles, mumps and rubella—administered after 1968 and after the first birthday—and against tetanus and diphtheria administered within the last 10 years. Official documentation must include immunizing agent, dosage, date on which immunization was administered and the signature of the administering medical official or laboratory slip showing positive immunity through titer (blood work) testing. In certain cases where immunization is medical inadvisable, a written statement from the student's health provider may exempt a student from receiving immunizations. In addition, in cases of sincere religious belief or for moral, philosophical or other personal reasons, a student may submit a statement in writing of their opposition to immunization. Medical exemptions and other written oppositions must be accompanied by a signed letter of opposition form available through the admissions office.

 3. **College Visits**. Beal College welcomes and encourages prospective students to visit the campus. Beal College requires applicants to schedule an admissions visit prior to registering for classes.
 4. Financial Aid appointments are encouraged for all applicants and can be scheduled through the Admissions Office.

J. **Students with Special Needs.** Any student requesting special academic consideration or services in relation to a learning and/or physical impairment must complete a Request for Accommodations and provide written documentation from a qualified professional verifying the extent of the impairment prior to registering for classes. This written documentation must include the following:

- a description of the impairment
- the history of remedial actions taken to date
- the qualified professional's recommendation to Beal College in handling the student's special needs.

K. **Proficiency Examinations.** Enrolled students exhibiting proficiency in certain courses offered at Beal College may request a proficiency examination; successful completion with a grade of 80% or better allows the student to bypass the course and receive the three credit hours associated with the course. The nonrefundable fee for the proficiency examination is \$100.00 and must be paid prior to taking the exam. Students wishing to take a proficiency exam may submit a written request to the instructor administering the exam. A proficiency exam may be taken only once and must be taken prior to beginning the course; once a student has attended a class, he or she may not take a proficiency exam. Failure to pass the proficiency examination will result in the student being required to take the course. Proficiency examinations may be taken in most courses. Additional information may be found in the current college catalog or by contacting the Student Affairs Office.

L. **Re-entering Students.** Students wishing to re-enter Beal College after a period of absence of six or more consecutive MODs (one year) are required to submit an updated Application for Admission. Re-entering students will be required to complete the academic requirements of their program from the catalog under which they are readmitted. Re-entering students are not required to pay the application fee again, as long as they can provide proof of prior payment if no proof exists in their student file.
